- Among the plethora of the English language versions of the Scriptures, we believe that the Authorised Version alone could spiritually quicken and renew us as it is translated from authentic and faithful manuscripts (precluding the reprint of the old versions like Geneva Bible, Matthew's Bible and William Tyndale's New Testament Translation, which have also been translated from the selfsame manuscripts). The New Testament is based on The Traditional Text (Textus Receptus or Received Text) whereas the Old Testament is based on the Hebrew Masoretic Text.
- Adhering to the Regulative Principle as opposed to the Normative Principle, we exclusively employ metrical Scriptures, particularly the Psalter, for hymnology at the place of public worship. The essence of this doctrine is that there must be a Scriptural warrant for every aspect of the public worship service and gathering (see Leviticus 10:1-3, Hebrews 8:5b).
- Creedwise, we subscribe to The Westminster Confession Of Faith (1646 AD, original version) and The Cambridge Platform (1648 AD), the caveat of the Separatist Puritans (including the Pilgrim Fathers, the actual founders of modern America and the true adherents of the Gospel of the grace of God through the shed and sprinkled blood of Jesus Christ!)
- The Holy Scriptures is a completely sufficient rule for faith and life. Wherefore all Christians from whatever social context and geographical backdrop are bound to be regulated by the biblical culture alone, including the primacy of preaching and the hallowing of the Lord's day, which is the first day of the week; the Lord's day is also called the Christian sabbath (as distinguished from the Creation sabbath; it is significant to note the difference between Exodus 20:11 and Deuteronomy 5:15; see also Psalm 118:24, Hebrews 4:8-10).
- We affirm with the Westminster divines that the inward illumination of the Spirit of God is necessary for a saving understanding of the sacred contents of the Scriptures [Ch. 1, (VI)]. *"Plead my cause, and deliver me: quicken me according to Thy Word. Salvation is far from the wicked: for they seek not Thy statutes"* (Psalm 119:154,155).
